Know a Federal Employee in need of Recognition?

Nominate them for the Arthur S. Flemming Awards this year. **Nominations will be accepted** between November 2, 2015, and January 31, 2016.

The purpose of the **Arthur S. Flemming Award** is fourfold:

- To recognize outstanding and meritorious achievement in working for the federal government;
- 2. To encourage the highest standards of performance in the federal service;
- 3. To enhance appreciation of our form of government and the opportunities and responsibilities that it presents; and
- 4. To attract outstanding individuals to a career in federal service.

Under the sponsorship of the Trachtenberg School of Public Policy and Public Administration at the George Washington University in Washington, D.C. and in partnership with the Arthur S. Flemming Awards Commission, the Arthur S. Flemming Award is one of the most prestigious awards for service in the federal government. The <u>distinguished roll of honorees</u> includes several whose names have been in the public limelight: Daniel Patrick Moynihan, Paul Volcker, John Chancellor, Neil Armstrong, Elizabeth Dole, Harrison Schmitt, Robert Gates, Dr. Anthony Fauci, Dr. Francis Collins, and William Phillips (Nobel Prize laureate).

Eligibility is restricted to individuals currently engaged in federal government service and who have served 3-15 years. Only years directly on the federal payroll are considered service.
